Main Duties and Responsibilities

- To co-ordinate specialist sub-contractors requirements both for PPM and reactive works.

- Maintain accurate job records/documentation in association with all site works.
- Be part of a call out rota and when required attend site emergencies, outside of normal working hours.
- Carry out tasks within typical building environments associated with air conditioning systems.

- If required to complete tasks at high level, working from platforms, desk surfers, tower scaffolding and ladders. All access equipment and PPE and any required training will be provided.
- Keep and maintain all company issued tools in a safe and serviceable manner.
